<b>University of California</b> <i>Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)</i>	<p>Six of University of California (UC) campuses offer guaranteed transfer admission to students from all California Community Colleges. 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<b>Brandman University</b> <i>Early Advantage Transfer Agreement</i>	<p>IVC and Brandman University (BU) have partnered to offer enhanced opportunities to transfer students to maximize transfer success and minimize the time and costs involved in attaining a bachelor's degree.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete Early Advantage Transfer Agreement (EAP)</li> <li>• Complete the BU undergraduate application</li> <li>• Minimum of 12 transferrable credits</li> <li>• GPA of 2.0 or greater</li> <li>• Must transfer to BU within one year of last term of attendance at IVC and up to four (4) years after their initial Early Admit Status at BU.</li> <li>• Once students are ready to transfer, they must complete a Transfer Request form and a Change of Location form</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows IVC students to be admitted to selected BU undergraduate programs while taking program-specific, articulated, transferable coursework at IVC. 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<p><b>Chapman University</b> <i>Admission Guarantee</i></p>	<p>This Transfer Agreement Guarantee (TAG) is made between Chapman University and Irvine Valley College to set forth the admission requirements for transfer from Irvine Valley College to Chapman for the following majors:</p> <p>Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Computer Information Systems, Computer Science, Environmental Science and Policy, French, Health Sciences, Japanese, Kinesiology, Math, Physics and Computation Sciences, Psychology, Software Engineering, or Spanish</p> <p>Irvine Valley College students wishing to transfer to Chapman University must take the following steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply for admission through the Chapman University application process and meet all other admission requirements and deadlines as outlined by Chapman University.</li> <li>• Complete the pre-admission course work for the intended major as specified. Make an appointment with IVC Counselor for more information.</li> </ul> <p>Major preparation courses are required for direct admission into the specific majors. 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<b>Arizona State University</b> <i>Admission Guarantee</i>	<p>Students may sign up for the Guaranteed Program for Admission at any point while attending a participating California community college. <b>Western Undergraduate Exchange</b> <i>Tuition Discount Program</i>	<p>The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) offers students in western states reduced tuition at participating 2-year and 4-year public colleges – up to 150% of the institution's regular resident tuition. In all cases, WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition. See the WUE website for commonly asked questions and a list of participating states and institutions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Evidence of academic performance another conditions (varies by campus)</li> <li>• Other conditions as placed by institutions</li> <li>• Reduced tuition is not automatically awarded to all eligible candidates.
